What are CEO Performance Roundtables?

A CEO Performance Roundtable is a gathering of 7-10 CEOs where, with the assistance of professional facilitators, leaders of non-competing companies can openly review their construction companies and share information in a focused effort to build breakthrough success for themselves, their families, their employees, and their customers.

CEO Performance Roundtables Mission

To help contractors improve their companies with the goals of making more money in less time with fewer headaches and a higher quality of life.

How Does The Program Work?

- Roundtable members are assigned to peer groups matched with regard to business size, type of construction, and non-competition guidelines (e.g. geographic proximity)
- Roundtable groups meet at rotating host company sites twice per year for about three days of peer review, learning, and sharing
- There are usually 7-10 companies represented in each peer group; many companies have two executives enrolled in the program
